Arc Midstate: 251-7272

Advocacy, education and support services for children and adults with developmental disabilities and their families.

ARISE: 253-5857

Adult mentors work with children with disabilities enabling their involvement in community activities.

Big Brothers Big Sisters of Central Minnesota: 253-1616

Mentoring for children and youth from one-parent families providing positive role models and life-long friendships.

Boys and Girls Clubs of Central Minnesota: 252-7616

Positive youth activities and guidance through year-round KIDSTOP after school child care, community clubs and skill building groups.
