What is a Financial Coach?

Individuals committed to helping individuals in our community achieve financial stability. Individuals will attend a 14 hour/2-day train-the-trainer workshop on the 'Four Cornerstones of Financial Literacy' curriculum to become a trained financial coach. There is no charge for the training that is offered September 23 & 24.

Financial coaches are asked to commit to educating a minimum of 20 people (teens and/or adults) on concepts from the workshop. Upon completion of this workshop, financial coaches will have technical financial information and skills in facilitating training and group sessions to help others make better financial decisions. Interested individuals are encouraged to attend a free informational session to get more information and sign-up to become a financial coach.
